## 8.1. Required Parts

The PUNCH G3 is shipped with an installation kit containing the following components.

## 8.2. Unpacking

Remove plastic wrap and straps from the package using a cutting tool




Lift of the lid and remove the installation kit and set it aside, it contains the items in section 1




Remove the four inner and 4 outer corner guards and then lift the shell straight up to remove it



Remove the tape holding the plastic bag closed and pull back the bag exposing the casters



Cut the corners of the lower box and with two people slide the punch so that the wheels overhang the edge




With two people, lift the punch holding the top cover so that it stands upright on the casters





#### Remove the plastic cover, tape, and foam from all locations




#### 8.3. Docking Procedure

Before docking the machine, adjust the casters so that the paper path is the same height as the upstream unit (710.5mm from ground) and the top of the machine is level.



To adjust the casters, loosen the top nut on the caster, and rotate the wheel by hand. Clockwise to lower, counterclockwise to raise. Once the desired height is achieved, tighten the top nut to secure the caster.





Install the front and rear docking brackets (Items 8, 9, and 11), on the upstream device. Note the rear docking bracket is the same part upper and lower.

Push the PUNCH G3 directly upstream so that the brackets slide into the openings



The upstream docking brackets should align with holes in the PUNCH G3






Once the brackets are aligned with the holes in the PUNCH G3, push the punch back so that it engages the alignment pins. Install item 10 in the lower right front bracket and secure the upper bracket using a M4 screw.






The PUNCH G3 comes with four spacers installed for the mounting of the downstream brackets.



Remove the two M4 screws from each spacer. The spacers are held to the PUNCH G3 with adhesive and should remain in place. Use these screws to secure the brackets provided with the downstream device. See the Konica Minolta Installation manual for more details.
